MAR 4/5: 24 HOURS FOR THE LORD

In the Diocese of Limerick the 24 hours for the Lord initiative will take place in Saint Augustine's Church, O'Connell Street, Limerick beginning with Mass at 4pm on Friday 4 March and concluding with Mass for the sick at 3pm on Saturday 5 March.

There will be opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation during the 24 hours and in keeping with the theme for the time of prayer, people are encouraged to make a special effort in the season of Lent, to celebrate the love and mercy of God. All are welcome to participate in this initiative.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

There is a newly developed proposal in Irish education to have a separate special subject called Education in Religious beliefs and Ethics. This would run as well as any RE teaching set up by the patron (eg Catholic RE). A national agency tasked with developing a new curriculum opened a consultation on the proposals - it will continue into spring 2016. During our own local consultation it became obvious that while supporting the concept of Education about Religions and Beliefs members of the education community had some concerns regarding the proposal. (Some of these are listed on the poster at back of the Church).

The proposed introduction of ERBE (Education about Religions & Beliefs ERB and Ethics) is a potentially significant change in the Irish primary school system, as such we would like to encourage people to become engaged in the consultation process.

There is the option to complete an online survey at www.ncca.ie/consultation/erbe but an advisory group gathered by the Council for Catechetics of the Irish Bishops' Conference and the Catholic Schools Partnership suggest that written submissions would be the better option.
